Where: 129 Morrison Street, Edinburgh EH3 8AJ Scotland

A friendly, all-day modern eatery with a passion for great tastes and flavours. Open every day for breakfast, lunch, brunch, cakes, or choose your favourites "to-go".

**Review**: "We love this little tearoom. The food quality is always high, and there is plenty of it! Normally our first place for breakfast when we visit Edinburgh. # Peacock Alley at Waldorf Astoria Edinburgh - The Caledonian

## Rankin's Café

Rakin Café is a small café with a menu filled with comforting classics, including freshly made sandwiches, home-baked cakes and their famous breakfast.
