Cherry & Heather Fine Food

Where: 7 North Gower Street, Glasgow G51 1PW Scotland

A small takeaway providing unusual sandwiches such as Indonesian bumbu kecap kaffir lime and lemongrass chicken. All the bread used is made locally, the meat is Scottish, and the vegetables are sourced from nearby.

Soup's On and the Cake Lady

Where: 115 Clarkston Road, Glasgow G44 3BL Scotland

A Liverpudlian and a Glaswegian couple serve locals with a very wide selection of unusual sandwiches, prepared and baked fresh daily.

A modern Scottish café and bistro offering artisan bakery, treats and sandwiches to locals. As well as selling a great variety of Scottish food they also offer a good selection of vegetarian food.

The Wilson Street Pantry

A laid-back atmosphere is found at Wilson Street Pantry, offering brunch to the city's customers seven days a week. They offer a good section of sandwiches, and all food is freshly made to order.
