# **Cherry & Heather**

Where: 7 North Gower Street, Glasgow G51 1PW Scotland

A small takeaway, but it tries to use locally produced, seasonal ingredients – although never just for the sake of it. Its bread is made locally, the meat is Scottish and the veg is mostly sourced from nearby too.

**Trip Advisor rating:** 4.5

**Review**: "Quick stop in for lunch. Really varied selection of hot and cold food. Sandwiches were outrageously good, fresh, and incredibly tasty".

## **Bon Tea Room**

Where: 279A St. Johns Road, Edinburgh EH12 7XF Scotland

Highly regarded tearoom with delicious sandwiches.

A modern cafe eatery in Edinburgh serving coffee, cakes, lunch, brunch, and breakfast with plates bursting with flavours.

# Polentoni

Where: 38 Easter Road, Edinburgh EH7 5RG Scotland

Polentoni is a friendly neighbourhood Italian bakery offering sandwiches, pastries, coffee and more.

**Review:** "Simple, delicious sandwiches of fresh crunchy bread; small, round, fluffy pizzas; cakes and pastries with price tags that make you wonder why everyone else is charging so much."

# **Thirsty Pallet**

Where: 15 Elm Row, Edinburgh EH7 4AA Scotland

A mother and son team run this friendly café and sandwich bar, offering cured meats and cheese, charcoal bread and homemade cakes.

**Trip Advisor Rating:** 5

**Review:** "You could construct your own sandwich from a choice of fillings and bread or choose from the menu. I opted for cheese, tuna, sweetcorn, and salad. It was packed with filling on really fresh baquette."
